


Habitat for Humanity Canada brings communities together to help families build strength, stability and self-reliance through affordable homeownership.

How Habitat works



The Habitat model

build

Families selected for Habitat homeownership help build their homes assisted by volunteers and community support.

buy

Habitat homeowners pay an interest-free mortgage geared to their income.

reinvest

Mortgage payments are invested into a revolving fund, which is used by the local Habitat to build more homes for families in their community.

Why affordable homeownership?

We know that affordable homeownership plays an absolutely critical role in helping families create a new foundation for a stronger future, one that's filled with possibilities and progress. Affordable homeownership allows families to foster the skills and confidence they need to invest in themselves and their communities, which has a life-changing impact on their lives.

The benefits of a Habitat home reach far beyond the four walls. Habitat families enjoy better health, education and employment prospects, and are less reliant on social services. In total, every Habitat home built helps create \$175,000 worth of benefits for society.



How you can help



Volunteer on a build site

Contact Habitat for Humanity South Georgian Bay to volunteer on a Habitat build site near you. You'll be provided all of the equipment and training you need, and will build under the supervision of an experienced crew leader — no prior build experience required.



Volunteer at events or in an office

Habitat has a wide variety of projects throughout the year to raise awareness, support and funds for homebuilding projects. There are many opportunities to contribute by getting involved in community events or at administrative offices.



Volunteer at a ReStore

Habitat ReStores are home and building supply stores that accept and resell quality new and used building materials. The money generated at the Habitat ReStore helps fund local Habitat homebuilding projects. Volunteer opportunities include customer service, stocking shelves, and accepting and testing donations.
